Check-In

All campers (Pre-Twinkle, Twinkle, Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced) are to check-in on Monday, July 25 from 7:30am – 8:30am. At this time, the camper will receive their schedule, take a theory placement test and settle any remaining tuition balance.

Seating Auditions

Music will be selected from pieces made available in May. A link will be sent out to each registered camper in June for the upload.
